## **Aurora Firefighters Conduct Rescue from Second Floor Apartment Fire on New Year's Day**

Aurora, IL – On January 1st at approximately 4:55 p.m., the Aurora Fire Department responded to a reported structure fire in the 300 block of Coventry Court. Initial 9-1-1 calls indicated a stove fire, but additional callers reported visible smoke and a possible occupant still inside the residence. Based on this information, the response was upgraded to a second alarm while units were enroute. A total of 4 engine companies, 2 truck companies, 3 medic units, and 2 chief officers – 29 personnel in all – responded to the scene.

First-arriving crews found smoke coming from the eaves of a two-story, eight-unit apartment building. One team located a woman trapped inside a second-floor apartment. Firefighters used a ladder to reach the window, made entry, and carried her to safety. Paramedics provided care at the scene and transported her to a local hospital for further evaluation.

Crews encountered a frozen hydrant but were able to establish an alternate water supply and extinguish the fire. The fire was contained to the apartment of origin, though a neighboring unit sustained water damage. Both units were deemed temporarily uninhabitable, while the remainder of the building remained intact. A dog from the fire-involved apartment was also located unharmed and safely turned over to family members.

“This was a fast-moving incident with a confirmed victim, and our crews acted quickly to get her out and contain the fire,” said Aurora Fire Deputy Chief Kevin Nickel. “We’re thankful she survived – and proud of the teamwork that helped prevent this from being much worse.”
