AURORA POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IN IDENTIFYING DRIVER INVOLVED IN HIT-AND-RUN

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Aurora, IL – The Aurora Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the driver involved in a vehicle vs. pedestrian hit-and-run accident that occurred in the early morning hours of Sunday, February 23, 2025.

At approximately 2:00 a.m., a pedestrian was crossing the Indian Trail Road bridge from north to south, between Route 25 and Route 31, when they were struck by what has been described as a white Toyota sedan. The vehicle was reportedly driven by a white female with blonde hair. The pedestrian suffered life-threatening injuries and was transported by air to Good Samaritan Hospital. The victim has since been discharged and is recovering at home.

Despite a thorough investigation, including review of nearby surveillance cameras, no leads have been identified. The Aurora Police Department is now turning to the community for assistance.
